(All players are expected to take the bus to and from the tournament. HGP Rules and Pennsylvania Law requires that players must obtain permission forms in order to travel with someone other than his parent.)

Parent Lodging:

Peek'n Peak Resort (Info Above) and there are hotels in downtown Jamestown that are more convenient to the rink.

What to Bring for Yourself:

- (1) **Any needed school books and materials.**
- (2) Comfortable Clothes for lodging and travel – there is a pool in the hotel.
- (3) Mr. Abramson strongly suggests a pillow for the bus.
- (4) Appropriate Dress Clothes for Games.
- (5) All playing equipment and uniforms.
- (6) Meal and Any Spending Money. Meals are the responsibility of the players. Most meals will be cheap or at Applebee's type places.

What to Bring for the Good of All:

- (1) Everyone is asked to bring one bag of food and one type of drink to be shared with everyone in the house. Please do not bring anything that needs to be prepared, but there is a kitchen/refrigerator/plates/etc. Bring enough to be shared (examples: a case of water, bag of chips with salsa, etc. etc.)

Decorum/Rules:
